



INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

The seaside operator, owner of Bagno STELLA MARINA DI DEL BIANCO RITA E C. SAS with headquarters in Cattolica Arenile area 45-46-47-49-50 – near via Lungomare Rasi Spinelli, as Data Controller of personal data pursuant to art. 4, of EU Regulation 2016/679 informs you, pursuant to art. 13 of the Regulation, which will process your personal data manually and/or with the support of IT means for the purposes indicated below:

PURPOSE OF THE PROCESSING, LEGAL BASIS AND ANY THIRD PARTY RECIPIENTS OF THE DATA

Your personal data will be processed for purposes related to the management of the reception of animals at the seaside, ordinary commercial relationships and the carrying out of communications both by paper and electronic means.

Your data may be processed for purposes relating to the security protection.

Furthermore, your data may be communicated to third parties, for technical and operational needs strictly connected to the purposes set out above and in particular to the following categories of subjects:

1. entities, professionals, companies or other structures entrusted by us with processing related to the fulfillment of administrative, accounting and management obligations linked to the ordinary performance of our economic activity;
2. to public authorities and administrations for purposes related to the fulfillment of legal obligations (health officials or Port authorities);

The provision of data is mandatory and any refusal to provide such data could lead to the failure to continue the relationship.

We point out that we may send you commercial and/or promotional communications relating to products and services similar to those which are the subject of the contractual relationship, unless you disagree.

LEGAL BASIS

Your personal data will be processed for the execution of a contract concluded with you or for the execution of pre-contractual measures adopted at your request.

The sending of commercial and/or promotional communications relating to products and services similar to those which are the subject of the existing contractual relationship takes place on the basis of the legitimate interest of the Data Controller.

DATA RETENTION TIMES

Your personal data will be kept for the time strictly necessary to carry out the purposes illustrated above and to fulfill the obligations established by law.

RIGHTS OF THE INTERESTED PARTY

Pursuant to articles 13, paragraph 2, and 15 to 21 of EU Regulation 2016/679, we inform you that regarding the processing of your personal data you may exercise the following rights:

- A. Right to obtain access to personal data and the following information:
 - confirmation of whether or not your personal data is being processed;
 - the purposes of the processing;
 - the categories of personal data;
 - the recipients or categories of recipients to whom the personal data have been or will be communicated;
 - if the data are not collected from the interested party, all available information on their origin;
 - the existence of an automated decision-making process, including profiling;
 - a copy of the processed personal data.
- B. Right to rectification and integration of personal data;
- C. Right to erasure of data ("right to be forgotten") if one of the following reasons exists:
 - the personal data are no longer necessary in relation to the purposes for which they were collected or otherwise processed;
 - the interested party withdraws consent to the processing of data and there is no other legal basis for the processing;
 - the interested party opposes the processing and there is no overriding legitimate reason to proceed with the processing;
 - the personal data have been processed unlawfully;



- the personal data must be erased to comply with a legal obligation under Union or Member State law to which the data controller is subject;
 - The data controller, if he has made personal data public and is obliged to delete them, must inform the other data controllers who process the personal data of the request to delete any link, copy or reproduction of his data.
- D. Right to limit processing in the event that:
- the interested party contests the accuracy of the personal data, for the period necessary for the data controller to verify the accuracy of such personal data;
 - the processing is unlawful and the interested party opposes the deletion of the personal data and instead requests that their use be limited;
 - although the data controller no longer needs them for the purposes of the processing, the personal data are necessary for the interested party to ascertain, exercise or defend a right in court;
 - the interested party has objected to the processing, pending verification of the possible prevalence of the legitimate reasons of the data controller with respect to those of the interested party.
- E. Right to lodge a complaint with the Guarantor for the protection of personal data, following the procedures and indications published on the Authority's official website www.garanteprivacy.it.
- F. Right to data portability, i.e. the right to receive the personal data concerning him/her provided to a data controller in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format and possibly transmit them to another data controller, if the processing is based on consent or a contract and is carried out by automated means. Where technically possible, the interested party has the right to obtain direct transmission of data from one data controller to another.
- G. Right to object at any time to the processing of personal data, including profiling, in particular in the event that:
- the processing takes place on the basis of the legitimate interest of the owner, after clarification of the reasons for the opposition;
 - personal data are processed for direct marketing purposes.
- H. Right not to be subjected to a decision based solely on automated processing, including profiling, except in cases where the decision: is necessary for the conclusion or performance of a contract between the interested party and a data controller, is authorized by Union or Member State law to which the data controller is subject or is based on the explicit consent of the interested party.
- I. Right to withdraw consent at any time.
The exercise of rights is not subject to any formal constraints and is free.
- J. Method of exercising rights
The interested party may exercise the rights at any time by sending:
